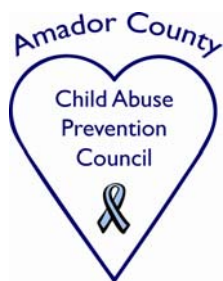

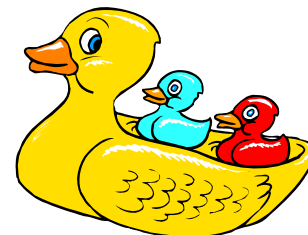
Come enjoy free food, crafts, games, music, and demonstrations.
